About the Institution

Padmabhushan Dr. Karmveer Bhaurao Patil founded the Rayat Shikshan Sanstha in 1919 to provide liberal and vocational education to the poor and needy students in rural, remote and drought prone areas of the Bahujan samaj in the fifteen districts of Maharashtra. From the beginning Karmveer identified and brought several poor, needy and intelligent students from the rural areas in spite of their caste, creed and religion and brought them in the stream of education. Later, most of these students devoted for the noble cause of education throughout their life. Due to the sacrifice of such Rayatians, the institution has become one of the most leading institutions of education in India. The institution is socially committed for holistic development of the students.

The institution has received several prestigious awards and honours from governments and NGOs for its valuable service for education and society. The prominent among these awards are Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Award from the Government of India in 1994, Dalit Mitra Purskar by the Government of Maharashtra in 1993, Rajashee Shahu Purskar by the Rajarshee Chh. Shahu Memorial Trust in 1998, Adarsh Shikshan Sanstha Purskar by Government of Maharashtra in 2001, Shri Sant Gadage Maharaj Seva Purskar by the Shri Sant Gadage Maharaj Mision Mumbai in 2002, Dr. Panjabrao Upakhya Bhausaheb Deshmukh Smriti Purskar by Yashwantrao Chavan Maharashtra Open University Nashik in 2003, Shahu, Phule, Ambedkar Purskar by Government of Maharashtra in 2013, Jivangaurav Purskar by Maharashtra Foundation (America and Sadhana Trust) in 2014, etc.

Today, the institution has 42 colleges, 439 high schools, 140 high secondary schools, 17 agricultural colleges, 5 technical colleges, 5 English medium schools, 8 tribal ashram schools, 50 ITI, 8 D. Ed. colleges, 45 primary and pre-primary schools, 95 residential hostels are working for betterment of the students, A total of 16948 teaching and non-teaching staff is working for the institution and students.

According to the changing policy of education, the institute has started to work for skill development of the students through Gurukul Projects, Rayat Knowledge Bank, Pre-recruitment Training Centres, Prakashan Cell, ICT Bank, Audio-visual Department etc. through Karmveer Vidyaprabodhini. For this, the skill development training and placements of the students, the institution has signed several MoUs with esteemed companies like Jain Irrigation, TATA Consultancy Services (TCS), BVG, BOSH etc. The institution is also giving focus on the skill development courses of the state and central governments in all branches of the institution.

In the present era of globalization and liberalization, the institution has changed all the concerns and references of liberal education. For imparting education, the institution has started to exercise the use of innovative methods and modern technology in all branches.
